4. You must practice before March 2nd to make sure you know the reading material.
 - a. Mrs. Harpin will have some picture books to choose from. You may bring an appropriate picture book from home or the public library, but it must be approved by Mrs. Harpin or Mrs. Chambless in advance.
5. You must be recommended by your ELA teacher (they need to sign below).
